

QOV Weave

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS FOR TOP:

Blocks: 3 to 3-1/2 yards miscellaneous, cut into 2 inch strips (50 strips total)

Alternate: 1-2/3 to 1-3/4 yard darks (27 strips)
1-1/3 to 1-1/2 yard lights (23 strips)

Border: 1-2/3 yards, cut 5 inches wide, length of grain

INSTRUCTIONS:

Sew together four sets of five strips and five sets of six strips.

Alternate: Sew four sets of dark-light-dark-light-dark
Sew five sets of dark-light-dark-light-dark-light



Measure the finished strips. The strip containing 6 fabrics should measure approximately 9-1/2 inches wide. Cut these strips into 9-1/2 inch squares (total of 20 blocks)



The strips containing 5 fabrics should measure approximately 8 inches wide. Cut these strips into 8 inch squares. (total of 20 blocks)

Cut both sets of blocks diagonally. (It doesn't matter which direction you cut as long as they are all cut the same)

Using two small and two large triangles to make the block shown below, sewing A to B and C to D. Be sure to match the right (90 degree) angles. Trim the excess fabric from the completed block. The individual blocks will measure approximately 11-1/2 inches.



Complete the quilt with the border as illustrated. The pieced portion of this quilt should measure approximately 44 inches x 55 inches. Adding a 5 inch border will result in a finished quilt measuring approximately 53 x 64 inch quilt.
